- **Beginning 1:00 a.m. Wednesday, May 20th to 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 26:** 13th Street from Market to Pine; Chestnut from Tucker to 15th; the west curb lane of Tucker, from Pine to Market; and the both curb lanes of Pine from Tucker to 14th.

Downtown Paving Street Projects

- Olive, from Broadway to 4th
- Locust, from Broadway to Tucker
- Broadway, from Olive to Pine (includes intersections at both ends)
- Broadway, from Clark to Gratiot (east curb lane only)
- 4th Street, from Walnut to Market
- 4th Street, from Chestnut to south of Convention
- 4th Street, from north of Chouteau (under railroad overpass)
- 10th Street, from Chestnut to Washington
