Closures

Interstate 70 reversible lanes

The St. Louis reversible lanes remain closed for St. Louis Ave. bridge construction until mid-August.

18th Street closure

Work on a bridge demolition project has required 18th Street to close between Chouteau to Market. It is scheduled to reopen in about two weeks.

8th Street sidewalk closure

Today the Roberts Tower crane will begin its two-week dismantling. The project will require closure of the 8th Street sidewalk between Washington Ave. and Locust from July 20-25.

Celebrate St. Louis weekend road closures: July 15-18 and July 22-25.

Beginning tomorrow afternoon and next Thursday, expect road closures around Soldier's Memorial, including: 13th between Market and Pine, Chestnut between 12th and 14th and Pine between 12th and 14th. Streets will reopen Sunday. For more info, visit: www.celebratestlouis.org

I-44 lane closures through the end of the month

Expect rolling lane closures on I-44 east and westbound as MODOT reconfigures and restripes the highway from five to four lanes. Eastbound paving should be complete by the end of the month.

I-55 closed from Loughborough to Broadway, July 23-25

The Interstate closes from 6 p.m. Friday to 5 a.m. Monday for demolition of two pedestrian bridges.
